

CLIL Lesson: REDUCE, REUSE, RECYCLE (First lesson of 3 R's)

Timing: 45 minutes

Age of students: 10 – 11 years (level A1 – A2)

Context and Prior Knowledge: Introduction to Environmental Studies

Lesson Steps

<p>1. 5 mins</p>	<p>Lead in and Connection to previous learning: Learners start with a new topic 3 R's.</p> <p>Warm up: Game.</p> <p>All children have to stay in the line, one after another. Teacher asks them: „Who likes dirty water – go to the right side and who likes clean water – go to the left side!“ Learners have to move to „their“ side – based on the answer that they had chosen. Teacher can use many other questions – for example: Whose mother and father can sort the waste - And whose can't...?, Who takes the bath....and who takes the shower? Who switches the computer off in the evening, and who doesn't? Who uses the same bottle for water every day... and who needs to use a new one every day? Children move from side to side.</p> <p>Then teacher stops the game and explains the new topic: 3 R's.</p>
<p>2. 15 mins</p>	<p>Reduce, Reuse, Recycle.</p> <p>Teacher shows 3R's – short PowerPoint. Page 2, 3, 4 : Teacher speaks about definitions of Reduce, Reuse and Recycle. Page 4: Learners can try to sort the waste on this page to the right bins, then the teacher shows the solution . She/he asks the questions: What does every „R“ mean? What else can we do? Can you give me more examples about 3 R's? Teacher writes new words on the blackboard and explains the meanings. Teacher answers learners' questions about 3 R's, if any. Page 5: Teacher asks the learners „What the word POLLUTION mean?“ Look at the pictures. Learners try to make their own definitions of pollution. Teacher will explain AIR, WATER and LAND pollution. 6th page explains the words THROW AWAY.</p>
<p>3. 15 mins</p>	<p>Worksheet activity 1 (Worksheet 3 R's). Teacher makes pairs of learners and gives them the Worksheet 3 R's. He/She explains the activity. Learners have to use scissors and glue. Then they stick the words to the right pictures. This activity helps to fix vocabulary from PowerPoint presentation.</p>
<p>4. 5 mins</p>	<p>Worksheet 2.</p> <p>Learners try to match sentences. At the end they correct and read the sentences together with the teacher.</p>

<p>5. 5 mins</p>	<p>Game again. Short version of the game from the beginning. Teacher asks new questions from the lesson. For example: “Who knows what the word Reuse means – go to the left, who doesn’t – go to the right!” etc.</p>
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
