

CLIL Lesson: *Danube River/ Geography*

Developer: Aura Serban

Timing: 50 minutes

Age of students: 9-10 years

Context and Prior Knowledge: Rivers in Romania

Lesson Steps

1. 3'	Lead in and Connection to previous learning:  Introducing the subject - Riddles (WS 1)
2. 5'	K-W-L Chart (on the board) Students are asked to say the things they know about the Danube River or Delta, and if they are interested in some particular facts. T tells them that the last column will be filled in at the end of the class.
3. 10'	ppt about Danube River: general information
4. 20'	4 thematic areas (Math, Artists, Geography, Biologists) –  Math, Geography, Biologists areas have half a flipchart paper (done before the class starts) with an A4 paper size marked empty area, and the worksheets related to their area. The Artists area has to solve 4 puzzles, all mixed in an envelope, with images on Danube River and Delta. When they finish, they will give the other areas the solved puzzles, according to the subject of their area. The others will glue them in the empty area on their paper.(WS 2) The activity is held while listening to Johann Strauss' song “Blue Danube ” ➤ geography- Danube river-reading comprehension (WS3 and 4) ➤ biologists- Danube Delta- choose the correct answer (WS 5 and 6) ➤ math- problems WS 7
5. 5'	Papers presentation -each area will present their work, while the others will check if they have the same information (the worksheets are related: half of the information on the Maths area can be found in the Geographers area, so on and so forth)
6. 5'	Completing the K-W-L Chart - students are asked to say the information they have learnt throughout the class
7. 3'	Danube Rosettes (WS 8) Each student gets a rosette as a reward for their work.
