





**CLIL Lesson: THIS IS US:THE GREEKS** 

Developer: Vana Koutalakidou

Timing: 50'

Age of students: 8-12 years old

Context and Prior Knowledge: Familiarization with Greek culture and habits (the lesson was realized during

a study visit to Romania-one of the Erasmus+ partners)

## Lesson Steps

1.	Lead in and Connection to previous learning: T introduces herself and informs the learners about her country of origin. She asks them if they have ever visited it and/or what they know about it. Then she shows them a video on Ancient Greek civilization and asks comprehension questions about the impact of Greek civilization on the world. 2.	Learners play a Jeopardy game (see Hellas Info Jeopardy pptx) on ancient and modern Greece in
	groups. More information about the correct answers is provided when learners interested. (In case
15'	the teacher wishes to expose the learners to all the supplementary material suggested, the time
	allotted to this particular step will have to be adjusted accordingly). More specifically, to expose
	learners to a map of the ancient Greek city-states the teacher should use the 'Greek City States
	Map' pdf. To learn more about the origins of the word 'Hellas' learners should be shown the 'Etymology of Hellas' pdf. By visiting the link <a href="https://study.com/academy/lesson/minoan-">https://study.com/academy/lesson/minoan-</a>

3.	Learners in groups are asked to make a poster for the Greek National Organization of Tourism.
	They are asked to include at least one piece of information of each category (general information,
20'	arts, food, lifestyle and education), give a relevant title, draw or use pictures the teacher gives
	copies of to them (see doc titled 'Pics for Greek poster') and present it to everybody
