

## CLIL Lesson: The Minoan Religion

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Timing: 50'

Age of students: 11-12 years old

Context and Prior Knowledge: The learners have already been taught about the Minoans' society and everyday life

### Lesson Steps

1. 5'	Lead in and Connection to previous learning: Learners are introduced to the topic of the lesson. <i>During your latest History lessons, you've been talking about an ancient civilization that flourished in Crete in the Bronze Age, the Minoan Civilization. Can you tell me something you remember about the way the Minoans lived? ....Today we are going to talk about these people's religion. Tell me some things you think we are going to talk about related with people's religion. (Possible answers: Gods/goddesses, temples, priests, religious practices, burial habits)</i>
2. 10'	T gives Ls Worksheet One and asks them to work in groups and match the titles to the paragraphs. Ls' answers checked and discussed
3. 15'	The T asks the Ls to read the text a second time and focus on Worksheet Two which asks them to fill in the bubbles/boxes of a mind map with words and pictures related to the text paragraphs. The Ls work in their groups again. Discussion of Ls' answers
4. 10'	The Ls discuss the requirements of task in Worksheet 3 and make suggestions about the information to be included in the summary on the Minoan religion. This task is assigned as homework.
5. 15'	The Ls are divided in two groups and they play a Jeopardy game (see ppt titled Jeopardy Game The Minoan Civilization) aiming to consolidate important information about the Civilization in question. A score keeper notes down the score of each group and announces the winners
